Show me. Show me what the good and bad of it. Show me everything. Just show me, me.

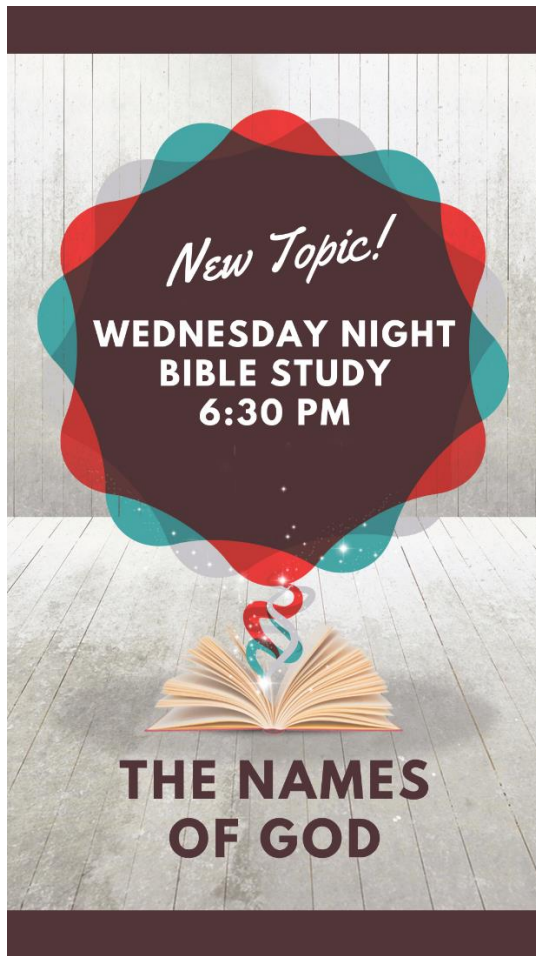
